6. Upon registration, proof of payment must be presented. Competitors must report at their planned event **half an hour before the scheduled start time to ensure that Range management activities can be accomplished to ensure punctual start of matches.**
7. Only ISSF matches will be squadded, competitors are to ensure that they give themselves ample time to complete all the events that they have entered for. No refunds for matches not shot.
8. A PPC competitor that wants to enter for all the PPC matches must take note that it will not be possible to shoot all the matches on one day. A competitor that wants to shoot in ISSF, NPA and PPC events must realize that all 3 days will be needed to accomplish this feat.
9. The last details will start at 12:00 on Sat 18 Feb 12.
10. Medals will be awarded to all grades from gold to bronze, provided that there are 5 or more competitors, if not only Gold will be awarded.

12. The trophy will have a unique Military flavor and will be in the form of a "Dog Tag". Only the **Champion** will receive recognition and it is the vision of the organizers that these tags will be sought after trophies for future SANDF shoots. The trophy will remain with the winner. **Note: PPC** competitors must indicate what scores are to be used before the start the match, failure to do so, will lead to disqualification from this award. This trophy is open for all not just the master class; the competitor with the highest score will win, irrespective of his grading.
13. **50 Yards Chairman's Cup.** A match based on the Mayleigh Cup will be presented. It will be called the "Chairman's Cup". The top ten competitors will be invited for a shoot out on Sat 18 Feb 12 at 12:00. A suitable Floating Trophy and R500 will be presented to the winner. Silver and bronze will be awarded to the fifth place.
14. **Rules and Regulations.** All the latest rules and regulations that govern the events will be enforced. Competitors are to pay particular attention to the management of the scores slips, as to ensure that all the relevant regulations are met. Improperly completed and signed slips will not be handled by the Scoring officials and the call if a score slip can be entered will be made by the Match Director or Chief Range Officer.
 - a. **PPC.** Scoring will be done by competitors. Disputes will be handled by the Range Officer.
 - b. **ISSF.** Scoring will be done on the range by the Range officer (gauging).
 - c. **NPA.** Scoring will be done on the range by the Range Officer.
15. **The Scoring Office will be out of bounds to all competitors and all queries must be directed to the Match Director or Chief Range Officer.**
16. Disputes will only be handled after the payment of a fee equal to the entry fee of the event being disputed. **Incorrect completed and mis-management of scores slips will not be allowed as a dispute.**
